MISSION OF THE INSTITUTE

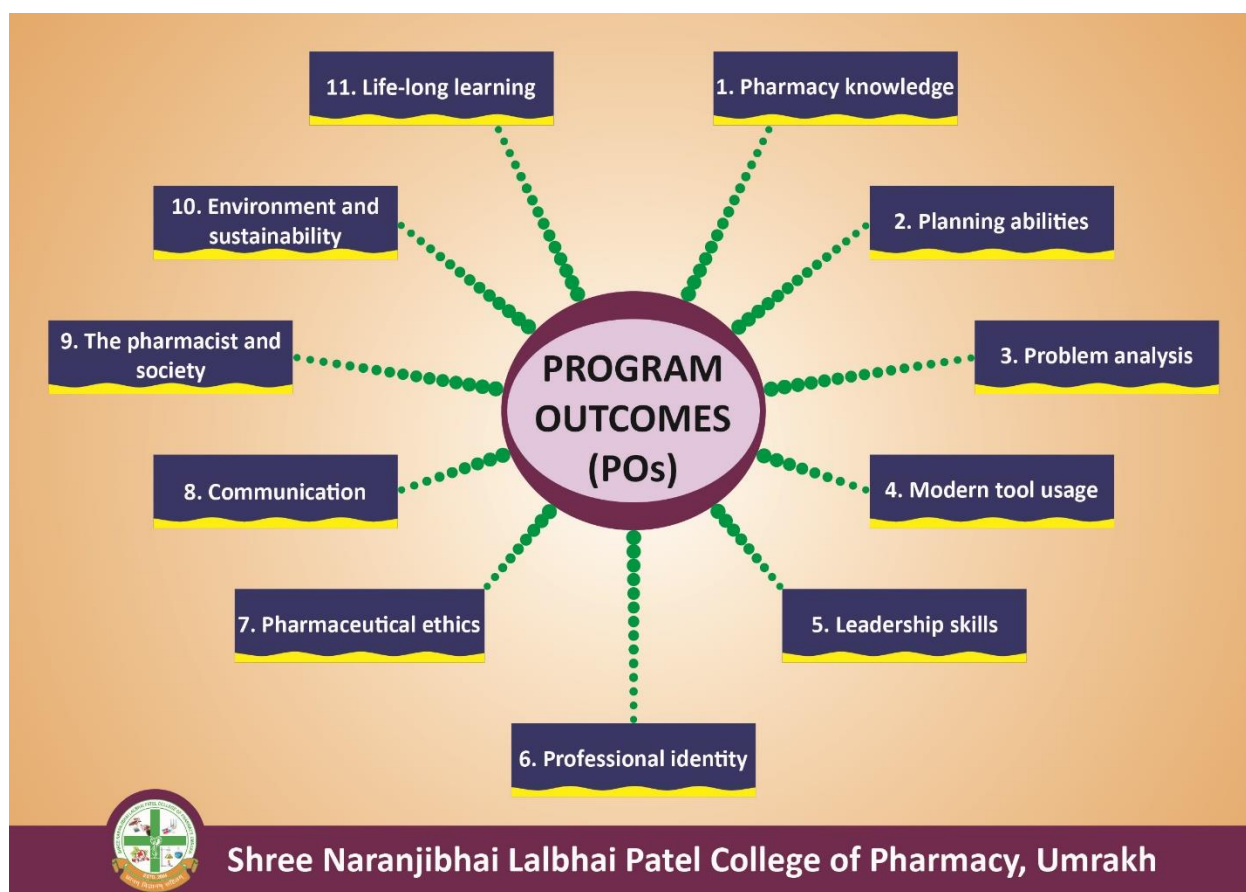

- One and all, the Culfest 2019 will be remembered for years to come.



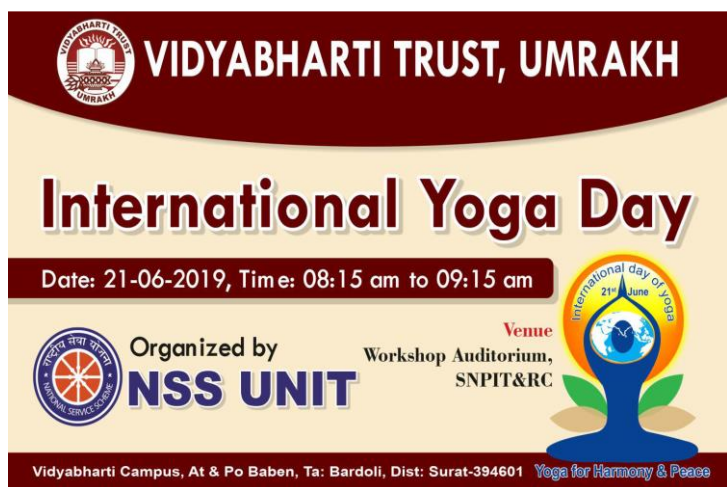
5. Pharma Battle

 - 3) Man of the Match: Tejas Patel, Raj Patel



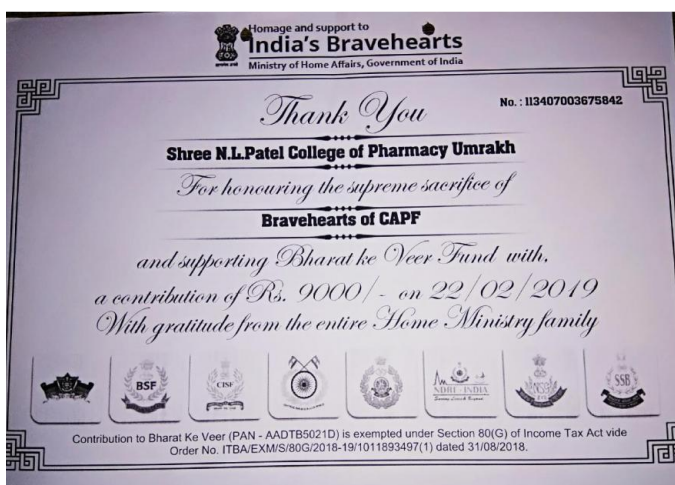
6. International Yoga Day
