- To march on par with current developments to become a professionally competent.



Shree Naranbhai Lalbhai Patel College of Pharmacy, Umrakh has organized a one-day Sophisticated Instruments Laboratory visit on 1st January 2022, for the final year B. Pharm & first year M. Pharm students.

Gujarat Technological University (GTU) established Graduate School of Pharmacy (GSP) from the academic year 2017-18. Graduate School of Pharmacy provides the facilities of Research Laboratories with sophisticated instruments to fulfil the departmental needs based on the research programs of M. Pharm and Ph.D. students. Facilities are equipped with the state-of-art equipment and Modern and Cutting-Edge Technology. Dr. Chainesh Shah and Mr. Bhumin Pathak along with 82 students visited Sophisticated Instruments Laboratory at GSP.

The faculty member had an interaction with Director & Professor Dr. Sanjay P. Chauhan. Orientation of institution was given by Dr. Kashyap sir. After orientation, all students were divided in four groups and were headed by one staff member of respective research lab who helped them to understand the research work going on the respective lab. Students have visited R & D division, analytical department and QA & QC departments where they have given demonstrations of sophisticated instruments such as HPLC, HPTLC, Particle Size Analyzer, FTIR, NMR, and LCMS. Students have also visited the Formulation & Development department, in which they got the knowledge about Rheometer, Optical Microscope, Rotatory Evaporator, Digital tablet hardness tester, Spray dryer, Freeze dryer, Digital Dissolution rate test apparatus, Disintegration test apparatus, Tray dryer, and Tablet Press Machine. Students took almost four hours to see complete set of instruments and this was followedby questions of students. This visit helps students to understand subject matter clearly in future also.

Resettlement and welfare of ex-servicemen and their families.














5. DAY'S CELEBRATION:
