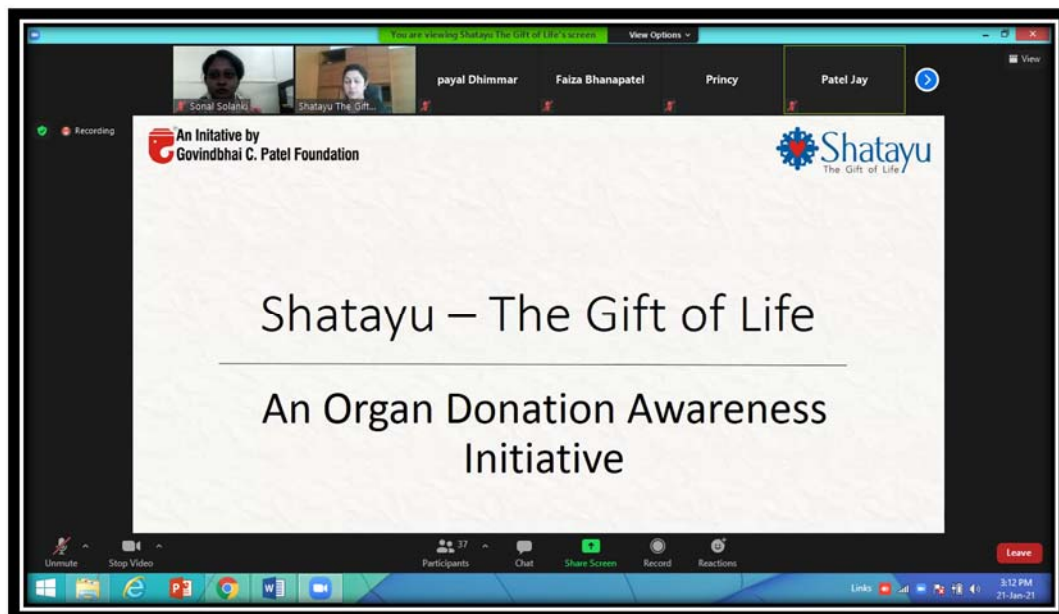
Report on Organ Donation-Save Lives

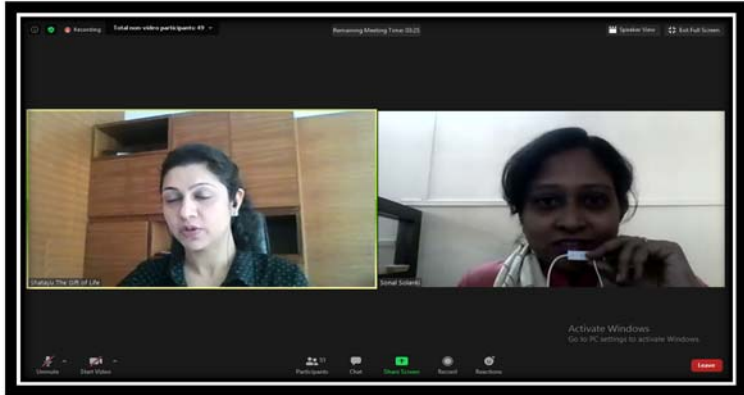
