The Sardar Patel Museum is situated in Bardoli - Surat, Gujarat, India. It was established in 1890. At the time of establishment, the museum was well known as the Winchester Museum. The museum was named Sardar Patel Museum after independence. The museum is also known as Sardar Sangrahalaya. Sardar Patel Museum has variety of things to explore. This museum is a rich repository of Patel's life arc as a political leader and thinker, and giving considerable space to other luminaries who crossed his path. The museum consists of a planetarium, ancient relics, paintings, science gallery, amphitheatre, art gallery, auditorium and restaurant. The audio in the auditorium is in three languages-Hindi, Gujarati and English. The museum has more than eight thousand relics and antiques. Students visited this museum for around two

hours and learn about the life of freedom fighters and their fight for freedom and independent India. students also explored the history of our nation, unity of people and zest for freedom. Students had an inspiratory visit of the Sardar Patel Museum.
