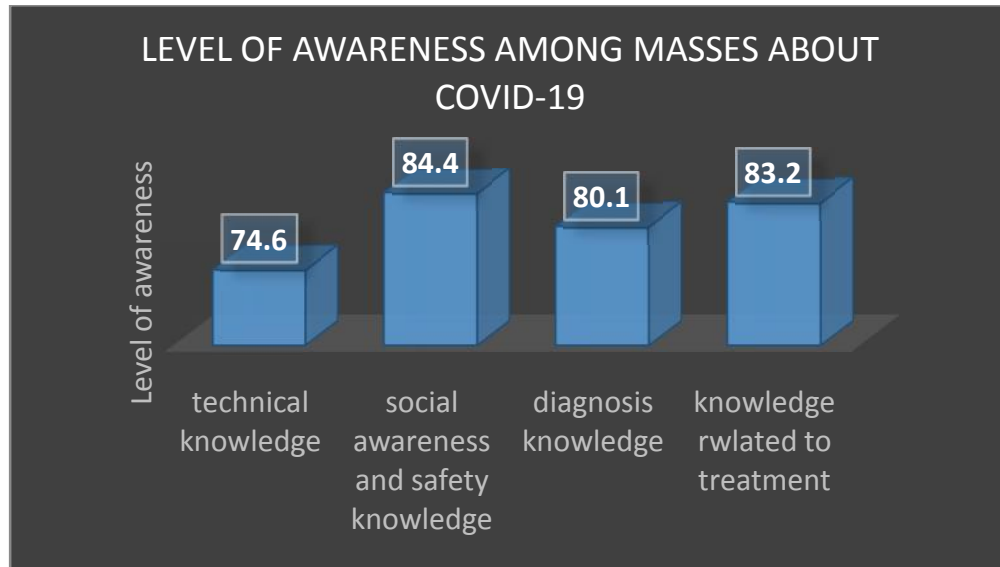

As we know, Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) is an infectious disease caused by coronavirus. The WHO has declared it a pandemic. The college communities are now involved in organizing webinars and quizzes for faculty and students to fulfil their needs and create awareness.
